

Exhibitor Definitions and Guidelines

Our old permanent status rules were creating some confusion and a small number of permanents were taking advantage of the system. As a permanent exhibitor you were given several privileges one of which was being able to select and retain a preferred position. Then once they had the position, they turned up irregularly and didn't even advise us if they were not going to attend. This was very unfair on those who wanted to occupy that site but couldn't because we had promised it to the person that in the end, didn't turn up.

As a result we are adopting a similar system used by other markets and which we believe will make it fair to everyone involved.

Simple Market Rule of Thumb

Our guidelines are very much common sense.

If it doesn't adversely affect anyone else and it makes the market look good, it's OK.

Communicate with each other. Work together, Support each other, we can all do well.

Most importantly, have a good time.

Product Guidelines

We have very few restrictions on products, but they must be legal and of good quality.

For example, No selling of illegal or stolen products and no dumping of rotten or over ripe produce etc. as this reflects badly on everyone.

If sub-standard products are being wilfully sold, you will be asked to leave, forfeit your site fee and it may affect future applications.

Raffle Sales, Petitions and Prospecting

Selling, prospecting and petition collectors must work from within their site.

Casual Exhibitors.

A casual exhibitor is an exhibitor who does not pay the annual membership and/or attends the market on an irregular basis. A casual exhibitor must book into the market after the close of the preceding market every time they wish to attend.

For those that attend regularly, we will try to keep you in the same spot but there are no guarantees.

(Permanent Exhibitors have the priority over sites occupied by casual exhibitors)

A casual exhibitor site fee is \$30.00 which includes compulsory public liability insurance.

Permanent exhibitors.

1. Permanent exhibitors pay an annual membership of \$270.00. (\$22.50 per month)
(Public Liability Insurance is \$24.00 per year if a current copy of your Certificate of Currency is not supplied.)
2. If a permanent exhibitor cannot make a particular market, they must inform us prior to the market so we can try to eliminate empty spots in the market.
3. The annual membership will run from the start of January market till close of December market.
(To join after January you will need to contact Phil.)
